

He holds a PhD in Politics, Human Rights and Sustainability from Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna University, Italy and a Masters in Peace and Conflict Resolution from the University of Kwa-Zulu Natal, South Africa.

Dr Juma was a professor at St. Augustine College of South Africa in Johannesburg, where he has contributed significantly to the initiation and improvement of the Peace theology program. He was previously the Regional Peace Advisor for Southern Africa with the Mennonite Central Committee (MCC), where he provided justice and peacebuilding materials to Country Representatives in Lesotho, Mozambique, South Africa, Swaziland, Zambia and Zimbabwe. Prior to his work with MCC, he was also the coordinator of the Dag Hammarskjöld Center for Peace, Good Governance and Human Rights at the Mindolo Ecumenical Foundation in Zambia where he organized the international seminars and the annual life and legacy commemoration activities of the Secretary General of United Nations, Dag Hammarskjöld.
